

Roo-Hide Brumby Saddle Series Rules & Point System

1. All horses that compete in the “**Brumby Rider**” class whereas the monies won are counted toward the Rider’s earnings:
 - a. Non-Pro
 - b. \$50,000 Amateur
 - c. \$35,000 Non-Pro
 - d. \$15,000 Amateur
 - e. \$2,000 Limited Rider
2. All horses that compete in the “**Brumby Horse**” class whereas the monies won are counted toward the Horse’s earnings:
 - a. Open
 - b. \$10,000 Novice
 - c. \$15,000 Novice NP
 - d. \$3,000 Novice
 - e. \$5,000 Novice NP
 - f. All Aged Event Classes
3. A horse or rider may show in multiple classes on any given day and use their best set of points (from an eligible class) to count toward the Brumby Saddle. *(Only one set of points will go towards your standings each day. A horse shown by multiple riders will only be allowed one set of points per day, but those may be accumulated throughout by different riders.)*
4. Points will be awarded using the Point Table below.
5. Either the Horse or Rider must show in 10 of 12 days of cutting.
6. Double points on Sundays! Each Sunday (3 opportunities) any points awarded will automatically be doubled!
7. No points will be awarded for a 0 or 60 score.
8. Saddles to be awarded on March 20, 2011 at the conclusion of the cutting!
9. Series include the January, February & March shows in Brawley, CA.
10. The San Diego Cutting Horse Assn. reserves the right to make changes to this contest as deemed necessary through their board of directors.
